Patterns will be available for you to print off the ISHSA website by September 17th. Patterns will be posted at the show office and in gate, but additional copies will not be available for taking.

## Entry Fees: ISHSA Classes: \$18.00 per class

To pre-register, complete the online entry or e-mail <u>chartersconsulting@gmail.com</u> by **MIDNIGHT**, **Wednesday**, **September** <u>22nd</u>. Pre-entries for the double point will have any necessary information ready for pick-up on **Friday after 2:00pm**; otherwise, you must enter in person at the show. The secretary will collect the show fees when you pick up your number or check in. Horses will not be allowed to enter classes unless class fees are paid, or a deposit is left with the show office. A signed "blank" check satisfies the "deposit" rule. Numbers will not be handed out without one of the above. Class scratches must be done two classes in advance of scratched class to receive a refund, or you will be charged for it. ISHSA will assess a \$25.00 fee for any bank returned checks and will hold your year end points until <u>all</u> money is paid.

## We will accept credit card payments with 4% fee. Form available in show office

## Please check in with the office and finalize your bill with the secretary before you leave the show grounds.

Stalls, Shavings and RV Spaces are available; reserve online at <u>www.fordidahohorsepark.com/Reservations.aspx</u> -- or call the Ford Idaho Horse Park (208) 442-3335 for more info. Load in day is Friday, September 24th. Stalls are \$30.00 per day/night. If you load in Thursday September 23rd for Ranch Horse day, stall is still \$30.00/day/night. Thursday thru Sunday would be 3 nights for a total of \$90.00, Friday thru Sunday would be \$60.00. One day would be \$30.00. If you haul in any earlier there is a \$17.00/day charge.

### Please remember ABSOLUTELY NO lunging in the indoor arena. (Ford Idaho Horse Park Rules)

NO dogs allowed inside arena building at any time. Any dogs on the grounds must be on a leash, no exceptions

**TRAIL CLASSES**- Trail will be held in the main arena Sunday morning. We will be running one pattern. Trail classes will begin promptly at 7:30am!!

<u>Warm up Trail Cost</u>: If riding in the Trail Warm Up on Sunday, there will be an \$8 trail warm up fee, unlimited goes and time. No need to reserve a time slot. Trail warm-up time will be from 5:00 am to 7:00 am. NO people will be allowed to walk the course during warm-ups!! This includes those showing in-hand trail. No Exceptions! Individuals will be allowed a 15-minute walk through (no horses) after Riding Warm-up.

# **Class and Award Information**

**"To qualify for ANY of the High Point awards – You MUST be CURRENT 2021 ISHSA MEMBER.** Awards are based on One Rider/One Horse Team – Your horse may be led in halter class by someone else. This is the ONLY exception. Only one halter class will count (for those horses with multiple registries. Halter class must be declared before start of show.

### \*\*\* You do NOT need to be an ISHSA member to show in any class and win the class ribbons\*\*\*

HALTER CLASSES - Grand and Reserve at halter is for first and second place winners only from each class. Please be sure to come back for Grand and Reserve in your division – Ribbons for Grand and Reserve!

<u>Champion of Champions at Halter</u>: Grand at halter for stallions, mares, and geldings will compete for this award. Neck ribbon for Champion of Champions at Halter!

Green Horse – 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing anywhere Beginning Horse – 1<sup>st</sup> year of showing Green Horse/Green Rider trail – Horse must be in its 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing western trail anywhere (with the last 10 years), or rider must be in his/her 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing walk-jog-lope western trail anywhere. Junior Horse – 5 years and under Senior Horse – 6 years and over <u>Ties for High Points</u> will be broken using the following: 1) The horse that placed highest under the call judge, 2) The horse that earns the most firsts, 3) The flip of a coin.
