Arena will be open until Midnight Friday evening (Ride in and around in-hand trail set up) and closed Saturday after Reining for trail set-up.

Patterns will be available for you to print off the website by September 22. Patterns will be available at the show office.

Entry Fees: ISHSA Classes: \$12.00 per class, plus \$2.00 per horse one-time promotion fee, plus \$2.00 per horse one-time awards fee – for a total of \$16.00 for the first class, then just \$12.00 for each additional class.

To pre-register, call *Anita Stephan (208) 869-\overline{0949}*, or e-mail <u>whodunit2009@hotmail.com</u> by *MIDNIGHT, Tuesday, September 26th*. Pre-entries for the double point will have a show packet ready for pick-up on Friday after 2:00pm; otherwise you must enter in person during the show. The secretary will collect the show fees when you pick up your number or check in. Horses will not be allowed to enter classes unless class fees are paid, or a deposit is left with the show office. A signed "blank" check satisfies the "deposit" rule. Numbers will not be handed out without one of the above. Class scratches must be done two classes in advance of scratched class to receive a refund, or you will be charged for it. ISHSA will assess a \$25.00 fee for any bank returned checks and will hold your year end points until <u>all</u> money is paid.

Please check in with the office and finalize your bill with the secretary before you leave the show grounds.

Stalls, Shavings and RV Spaces are available; reserve online at <u>www.fordidahohorsepark.com/Reservations.aspx</u> -- or call the Ford Idaho Horse Park (<u>208)442-3335</u> for more info. Load in day is Friday, September 29. Stalls are \$27.00 per day/night. (Horse Park increased their rates for 2017.)

Please remember ABSOLUTELY NO lunging in the indoor arena. (Ford Idaho Horse Park Rules) NO dogs allowed inside arena building at any time. Any dogs on the grounds must be on a leash, no exceptions This show is also approved for PAC Credits, ACAAP Approved and AHA-OIEP Approved.

TRAIL CLASSES- Trail will be held in the main arena Sunday morning. We will be running two trail courses and will have each main judge paired up with one local judge. One course will be the walk/trot course and one course will be the course for loping horses. This will eliminate keeping all our exhibitors waiting needlessly. We will post which course is which. We will host a paid "warm-up" trail session on Sunday morning before the show starts, from 5:30 AM until 8:00 AM. You can walk the course from 8:00 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. You do not need to be in show attire to ride in the warm-up, but you <u>MUST</u> have your horse exhibitor number displayed clearly, so we can account for your warm-up session.

<u>Warm up Trail Cost</u>: If you are entered in trail you will be accessed an \$8 trail warm up-fee per course, unlimited goes and time, per course. No need to reserve a time slot. Trail warm-up time will be from 5:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. <u>No people will</u> <u>be allowed to walk the course during warm-ups!</u> No Exceptions! You will be allowed a 15 minute walk-thru after riding warm ups.

CLASS AND AWARD INFORMATION

<u>"To qualify for ANY of the High Point and Circuit awards – You MUST be CURRENT 2017 ISHSA MEMBER.</u> <u>High Point. Reserve and Circuit awards are based on One Rider/One Horse Team – Your horse may be led in halter class</u> <u>by someone else. This is the ONLY exception. Only one halter class will count (for those horses with multiple registries.</u> <u>Halter class must be declared before start of show.</u>

*** You do NOT need to be an ISHSA member to show in any class and win the class ribbons***

<u>HALTER CLASSES</u> - Grand and Reserve at halter is for first and second place winners only from each class. Please be sure to comeback for Grand and Reserve in your division – Neck Ribbons for Grand and Reserve!

<u>Champion of Champions</u>: Grand at halter for stallions, mares and geldings will compete for this award. Neck ribbons for Champion of Champions!

<u>REINING - The High Point Reining Horse</u> (classes 66 or 67 or 68,69 and 70) – must show all 3 classes to qualify.

<u>HIGH POINT IN-HAND HORSE-</u> <u>In-Hand horse/handler will be eligible only to those who exhibit animals</u> <u>that do not drive or ride</u>. You must exhibit in the In Hand Trail class (class 26 or 27) as well as your respective halter class (class 1-5, 7-11 or 13-17) to qualify. Your age division showmanship class (class 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25) also counts for High Point In-Hand. Highest total of points in those "3" classes will win award!

<u>HIGH POINT GYMKHANA HORSE</u> – Classes 114, 115, 118, 119, 122, 123, 126, 127 counts for this High Point. You must show all 4 classes in your age division to qualify for this award. All times will be added together, the "fastest" combined times wins High Point. <u>Walk-Trot games do not count towards this award.</u>

<u>HIGH POINT - 11 & Under (Walk-Trot)</u> – Classes 24, 33, 42, 86, 94,74 and horse MUST be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (Classes 1-5 or 7-11). Halter points count using $1^{st}=6$, $2^{nd}=5$, $3^{rd}=4$, $4^{th}=3$, $3^{rd}=2$, $6^{th}=1$.

<u>HIGH POINT – Walk-Trot Limited Rider – 12 yrs and over</u> – Classes 32, 43, 85, 97, 72 and one of the following: 20, 21, 22, or 23 and horse MUST be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (class 1-5, 7-11 or 13-17). Halter points count using $1^{st}=6$, $2^{nd}=5$, $3^{rd}=4$, $4^{th}=3$, $3^{rd}=2$, $6^{th}=1$.

<u>HIGH POINT – 13 & Under -</u> Classes 23, 38, 52, 91, 102,75 and horse MUST be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (Classes 1-5 or 7-11). Halter points count using $1^{st}=6$, $2^{nd}=5$, $3^{rd}=4$, $4^{th}=3$, $3^{rd}=2$, $6^{th}=1$.

<u>HIGH POINT – 14 thru 18</u> – Classes 22, 37, 51, 90, 101,76 and horse MUST be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (Classes 1-5 or 7-11). Halter points count using $1^{st}=6$, $2^{nd}=5$, $3^{rd}=4$, $4^{th}=3$, $3^{rd}=2$, $6^{th}=1$.

<u>HIGH POINT – 19 thru 49</u> – Classes 21, 36, 50, 89, 100, 77 and horse MUST be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (class 1-5, 7-11 or 13-17). Halter points count using $1^{st}=6$, $2^{nd}=5$, $3^{rd}=4$, $4^{th}=3$, $3^{rd}=2$, $6^{th}=1$. Gaited Horse Contestants are eligible for this award as well, so Gaited horse classes: 21, 34, 60, 61, 87, 103, 104, 73 (choose just 6 of 8 classes – form will be available) and horse MUST be shown in Halter to Qualify for the award (Classes 4, 10 or 16).

<u>HIGH POINT – 50 and over</u> – Classes 20, 35, 49, 88, 99, 78 and horse MUST be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (class 1-5, 7-11 or 13-17). Gaited Horse Contestants are eligible for this award as well, so Gaited horse classes: 20, 34, 60, 61, 87, 103, 104,73 (choose just 6 of 8 classes – form will be available) and horse MUST be shown in Halter to Qualify for the award (Classes 4, 10 or 16). Halter points count using $1^{st}=6$, $2^{nd}=5$, $3^{rd}=4$, $4^{th}=3$, $3^{rd}=2$, $6^{th}=1$.

<u>HIGH POINT LARGE CART</u> – Classes 28, 30, 40, 46. Horse MUST be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (class 1-5, 7-11 or 13-17). Halter points count using $1^{st}=6$, $2^{nd}=5$, $3^{rd}=4$, $4^{th}=3$, $3^{rd}=2$, $6^{th}=1$.

<u>HIGH POINT SMALL CART</u> – Classes 25, 29, 31, 41 and 47 Horse MUST be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (class 1-5, 7-11 or 13-17). Halter points count using $1^{st}=6$, $2^{nd}=5$, $3^{rd}=4$, $4^{th}=3$, $3^{rd}=2$, $6^{th}=1$.

<u>CIRCUIT AWARDS</u> – Each High Point will have a "Circuit award" combining the Spring Double Point show points with the Fall Double Point show points, for an overall CIRCUIT award prize! <u>You must show in BOTH Double Point</u> shows to qualify for this award! You must show in the same qualifying halter class in Spring & Fall show (for horses with multiple registries).
