<u>2025 Show Approval Form</u> <u>IDAHO STATE HORSE SHOW ASSOCIATION</u>

Please send this form with the approval fee of \$30.00 (pays for the show to be covered by ISHSA's insurance) to the ISHSA secretary. <u>ISHSA Sanctioned shows must offer a minimum of 60 ISHSA classes on their show bill. If the show bill consists of fewer than 60 classes, 90% of the show bill will be required to be ISHSA classes.</u> The show bill needs to be approved prior to being published. Showbill should be published 60 days before the event.

<u>Submit the completed show bill (cover sheet & class list).</u> Remember that any high point being offered must have ALL the classes that qualify for a given award clearly stated on the show bill. You must have the judge's names listed, location, dates, times, etc. <u>Use the attached class list which is also published in the rulebook for correct language</u>. Please e-mail the whole show bill to John Lindley at john@johnlindley.net. He will distribute this information to the rules committee for corrections. When all corrections are made John will send the show bill to the website person for posting who will then send it to our newsletter editor. ONCE THE SHOWBILL HAS BEEN PUBLISHED, NO CHANGES CAN BE MADE WITHOUT A 30 DAY NOTICE.

Current cap for class fees is \$10. Shows may charge less if they want.

\$1/per entry of ISHSA classes is due back to ISHSA for year end awards no less than 14 days after completion of the show. (NO patterns are to be posted on social media until they have been posted to the ISHSA website)

Member organizations: list the name of your delegate & alternate. Each member organization is eligible to have a delegate that <u>attends all ISHSA general meetings</u> & <u>has a vote in executive meetings</u>. Only the designated delegate (or alternate) may vote, so please keep this information updated with the ISHSA secretary. <u>We encourage individuals to sponsor shows as well</u>. Individual members holding shows are NOT eligible to have a delegate. We encourage ALL members to participate in all meetings.

The 2024 dates give the sponsoring clubs first call until Feb. 28, 2025. After Feb. 28, 2025, dates become available for scheduling by other clubs. Please reserve your show date(s) early.

Green horse must be in its 1st or 2nd year of showing ranch anywhere.

General notes for all classes:

- 1. The term "horse" is used as a generality in reference all equines.
- 2. Horses may only be cross-entered in breed specific classes if the horse is double registered and has the appropriate registration papers.
- 3. When a specific breed is designated, horses may only compete in classes for which they are appropriately registered.
- 4. Those showing in the "11 years and under walk/trot (may not cross enter)" category may show mares or geldings in halter classes, but may not show in any other classes that don't specifically have the title "11 years and under walk/trot (may not cross enter)". Equines may cross enter.
- 5. Walk/Trot Limited Rider (may not cross enter) classes are restricted classes. Riders may not cross-enter into any class that involves loping or cantering. Riders may enter halter, showmanship age group, and walk/trot only classes, but are otherwise limited to classes with the title "Walk/Trot Limited Rider". Equines may cross enter.
- 6. COLTS/STALLIONS: Persons under the age of eighteen (18) are prohibited from showing colts or stallions in any ISHSA class. For the purposes of showing, a "colt" is defined as any unaltered male equine under the age of four (4) and a "stallion" is defined as any unaltered male equine age four (4) and over. An altered male equine is defined as a gelding regardless of the equine's age.
- 7. For the purposes of "Green" and "First Year Beginning Horse" classes, a "year of showing" equals showing, under saddle, under 4 or more judges within a calendar year.
